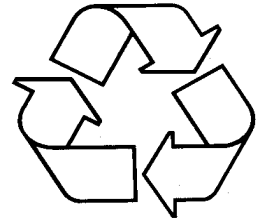


**NOTICE TO TOWN OF FARMINGTON RESIDENTS
EFFECTIVE TUESDAY, JANUARY 11, 2011
THE NEW TRANSFER STATION SCALE HOUSE WILL BEGIN
WEIGHING ITEMS FOR DISPOSAL AT THE EXISTING LANDFILL**



How does this impact the residents of the Town? The landfill will continue to be open to receive waste materials until December 31, 2011. The new transfer station scale and scale house will be used to weigh waste materials for the purpose of determining the charges for waste disposal. Separation of the following items is mandatory for disposal and/or recycling in the Town of Farmington.

The following waste materials will be accepted at the landfill:

Regular Household Trash (MSW) **	No recyclables, wood or metal, and must be in 30 gallon CLEAR trash bags as of February 2, 2011 .
Aluminum Beverage & Tin Cans	Must be clean
Glass	Must be clean, empty, clear, green or brown bottles. No window glass, dishes, etc.. No caps, lids or corks.
Plastic	#1 & #2. Must be clean with no lids. No brown plastic liquor bottles. No black platter plates. No hardened black plastic, etc. (No # 3, 5, or 7)
Cardboard	(Corrugated only, clean, no foam or packing materials)
Magazines/ Newspapers/ Paperback Books Mixed Paper	Clean, dry, no tied bundles, no hard covered books Junk Mail, shirt and cereal boxes, other dry goods containers, office paper, glass non-corrugated boxes. No wax coated containers or corrugated cardboard. No bathroom trash or plastic bags
Batteries	Automobile and household batteries
Brush	No stumps. No logs/branches greater than 6" diameter
Yard Waste	Leaves and grass clippings only
Ash	Clean wood ash only
Inert Materials **	Concrete, ceramic, porcelain, masonry
White Goods **	Refrigerator, freezer, air-conditioner or de-humidifier
Scrap Metal	Scrap iron
Waste Oil	Clean waste oil only
Asphalt Shingles **	(No metal flashing or nails)
Furniture & Bulky Items **	Furniture, mattresses and brown goods and non-freon items
Construction Debris **	Dry sheetrock, pressure treated lumber, creosote lumber, treated and untreated lumber and insulation
Tires **	Auto, construction and heavy equipment
Computer Equipment & Electronics **	Hard drives, computer components, CPU's, Laptops, Copiers, Printers, Keyboards, UPS systems, electronic gaming devices and components
Televisions **	Includes consoles and cabinets
Light Fixtures **	Fluorescent bulbs, ballasts removed from fixtures

** Fees apply for this type of waste material and are subject to change. Please see reverse side for updated fee schedule. Also, please see the reverse side of this flyer for hours of operation and locations to obtain bag stickers and Landfill Permits.

UPDATED WASTE DISPOSAL FEE SCHEDULE

Municipal

Solid

Waste (MSW): Pay Per Bag remains in effect. Bag stickers are **\$1.50 each**. **30-gallon clear bags are mandatory for disposal of MSW as of February 2, 2011.**

Inert Materials: \$0.08 per pound (Weighed at transfer station scale house).

Asphalt Shingles: \$0.08 per pound (Weighed at transfer station scale house).

Furniture &

Bulky Items:

\$0.08 per pound (Weighed at transfer station scale house).

Construction

Debris:

\$0.08 per pound (Weighed at transfer station scale house).

White Goods:

Refrigerator or freezer \$17.00, Air conditioner \$17.00, De-humidifier \$17.00.

Computer

Equipment:

Monitors \$12.00, CPU's & Laptops \$3.00, Desktop copiers, Printers, Scanners, Fax Machines, etc. \$10.00, Floor copiers/Printers etc. \$27.00, Keyboards, mouse, computer speakers (per pair) \$3.00, UPS (Battery backup systems) \$10.00

Tires:

Car/Pickup 16.5" or less \$4.00, 17" to 19" \$5.00, with rim \$7.00, Construction Truck \$26.00, Heavy Equipment \$61.00.

Televisions:

Up to 15" \$12.50, 16" to 24" \$17.50, 25" or larger \$27.50.

Light Fixtures:

\$2.50 per 4-foot bulb, \$5.00 per 8-foot bulb and \$7.50 per ballast.

NOTE: Bag Stickers & Landfill Permits **will be available at the Transfer Station during December and January of each year, and may also be obtained at the Highway Dept.** located in the Municipal Office, 356 Main Street throughout the entire year. Temporary Landfill Permits **are issued at the front desk of the same building.**

Bag stickers will also be available for purchase at the following locations: Cumberland Farms, Marketplace, Mros Variety, Mills Market, Big Apple, AJ Cameron's, Route 153 Country Store.

Clear Bags will also be available for purchase at local retail stores in the Town of Farmington and in retail stores of Towns adjacent to Farmington.
