Instructions for Permit Applications

1. All information must be printed legibly.
2. Owner name, mailing address and phone number.
3. Location and address of work site.
4. Complete description of work to be done.
5. Number of fixtures, appliances and equipment to be installed.
6. Plans must be submitted on all new buildings and major renovations.

**Notes:**

The property owner of record may exercise their right to perform their own plumbing work on their residence if he or she lives at the residence and the residence is a Single Family Dwelling occupied by the owner of record

It is the responsibility of all contractors, electricians and plumbers to obtain the necessary permits from the Code Enforcement office at Municipal Building *before* ANY work has begun. Work must begin within six (6) months of the issuance of any permit.

Permits are non-transferable. If this is an "After the Fact" permit, it will be subject to a fee two times the normal permit fee.

Electricians and plumbing contractors must have a valid license from the State of New Hampshire to obtain a permit. Permits are not transferable.

It is the responsibility of the contractor to obtain all inspections required. A rough-in inspection is required before any work is covered, and a final inspection is required when all work is complete. A Notice is required for any inspection. *This signed application constitutes consent on the applicant's part to allow for all inspections at the property location listed.*

No permit will be issued until all of the above information is furnished, and all the above conditions met.

**INSPECTIONS REQUIRED:** (Notice required)

1. When job is complete, and system under pressure.(Final).

Code Enforcement Approval would certify that the applicant could proceed with installation of plumbing fixtures in accordance with specifications submitted. Any deviation from the specifications submitted will require an amendment to this permit or additional permits.
