**VETERAN'S CREDITS:** the following credits are available:

- 1. Veteran's Credit: \$750 (for qualifying veterans, their spouse or widow)
- 2. Service-Connected Total & Permanent Disability: \$2000 (for qualifying veterans, their spouse or widow)
- **3.** Surviving Spouse: \$2,000 (for spouse of any person who was killed or who died while on active duty in the armed forces of the U.S.)
- **4. Total Exemption:** Total tax exemption for applicants who meet all requirements of State RSA 72:36-a **and** who own a specially adapted homestead acquired with VA assistance.

## QUALIFICATIONS

- A NH resident for at least 1 year preceding April 1<sup>st</sup> of the year the credit is requested.
- Property must be the veteran's principal place of abode
- Property must be owned by the veteran or the veteran's spouse
  - Must have served at least 90 days in a qualifying war or conflict
    - **WWII:** December 7, 1941-December 31, 1946
    - Korean Conflict: June 25, 1950-January 31, 1955
    - Vietnam Conflict: December 22, 1961-May 7, 1975
    - **Vietnam Conflict:** July 1, 1958-December 22, 1961, if veteran earned Vietnam Service Medal or Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal
    - Persian Gulf War: August 2, 1990 –
    - Any other war or armed conflict that has occurred since May 8, 1975, and in which the veteran earned an Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal or Theater of Operations Service Medal
- Must have been honorably discharged
- Must submit DD214 to Town along with Form PA-29
- If applying for Service-Connected Total & Permanent Disability Credit, must have letter from Veteran's Administration
- Deadline to apply is April 15<sup>th</sup>
