HOURS OF OPERATION & ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

When you arrive at the Transfer Station, please see an attendant before tossing anything in the disposal cans. All materials need to be properly sorted for collection from Waste Management. This listing should only serve as a pricing guide for organizing materials before arrival to the Transfer Station.

Landfill Window Sticker Permits: You can obtain the window stickers at the Transfer Station and at the Town Clerk / Tax Collector office. In order to obtain one, you will need to show your vehicle registration. If your vehicle is not registered in Farmington, you can obtain a temporary permit from the

Bag Stickers: \$1.50 per bag and are good for disposal of the one 30 or one 33-gallon clear bags for household trash. Two Bag stickers are required for the disposal of one 55-gallon size clear bag of household trash. Bag stickers are available for purchase at the Transfer Station and at the Town Clerk / Tax Collector office, Mills Market, Cumberland Farms and Crowley's Variety and grill.

THE FOLLOWING SOLID WASTE ITEMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE TRANSFER STATION:

Regular Household Trash: Must be disposed of in 30, 33, 55-gallon CLEAR trash bags. Regular Household trash is also known as domestic waste or residential waste, which is refuse generated by households. This type of non-hazardous waste is made up of food scraps as well as the containers they come in, newspapers, bottles, cans, etc. parts of this group, can be classified as recyclables. No other items are classified in this category or will be accepted in the trash bags. These bags must have the proper bag stickers affixed to the outside.

The items below are priced at \$0.08 pound and will be weighed with our certified scale, these are examples of the materials for each category, *however everyone must see an attendant:*

Construction & Demolition Debris:

Dry sheetrock, plaster and lathe (non-asbestos containing materials), all types of lumber, and insulation.

Inert Materials:

Concrete, bricks, masonry, ceramic as well as porcelain items (sinks, tiles, toilets, dishes etc.)

Furniture & Bulky Items:

Furniture, clothing, blankets, bedding, pillows, animal beds, couches, mattresses, non-freon containing appliances.

Asphalt Shingles:

Clean asphalt shingles only (non-asbestos containing materials). No metal flashing or nails will be accepted with shingles, for safety – these items must be removed.

Light Fixtures & Thermostats:

Florescent bulbs and ballasts. Ballasts must be removed from all fixtures. \$2.50 per 4-foot bulb \$5.00 per 8-foot bulk \$7.50 per ballast

Propane Tanks: \$1.00 1 lb. tank \$2.00 up to 20lbs **For pricing on larger tanks, see attendant*

THE FOLLOWING RECYCLING GUIDELINES APPLY TO THE TRANSFER STATION:

Scrap Metal:

Scrap iron (no petroleum containing products or Freon)

Aluminum Beverage/Tin Cans:

Must be cleaned before disposal.

Yard Wastes:

Shall consist of grass, leaves, plants, etc. and incidental small branches that were collected during raking/cleanup. No brush is allowed. **See attendant for instruction*

<u>Cardboard</u>: Corrugated cardboard only. Must be clean and contain no foam, plastic wrap or packing materials. Must be Flattened. *No waxed cardboard will be accepted.*

Paperback/Books: Please send reusable books with or without barcodes in good or better condition. We are <u>unable</u> to accept the following books/items: Newspapers, Encyclopedias, Phone Books/directories, All magazines including National Geographic Publications, "Time Life" books, Reader Digest Condensed Novels, *K-12 text books including Teacher Editions (see below), Advanced Readers copies/Uncorrected Proof, Coloring books, Wet/Moldy/Smelly/Damaged books, Foreign Language/Asian Printings (only send books in English), "Free" Government books, Spiral bound/3-ring binder books of any kind, *Non-book items such as VHS, cassette tapes and vinyl records (see below). <u>*We DO accept college textbooks, plastic covered books.</u>, CD's, DVDs, and video games. Please keep these in a separate box/container.

Disposal of Medical Sharps: Please place your needles and syringes in a <u>Medical Sharps Container Only</u>. Laundry detergent of coffee container are no longer acceptable. *Place a sticker label on it marking it "Medical Sharps Container- DO NOT recycle.*" The attendants are not allowed to handle or accept these disposals in any other condition. Thank you.



Disposal of Animal Carcasses is PROHIBITED!
