### ATTENTION: OWNERS OF SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS



This letter is to inform you that the Town of Farmington will begin assessing Solar Energy Systems in 2019. The Town of Farmington currently offers an exemption in the amount of \$5,000 off the assessed value of a Solar Energy System. The deadline to apply for this exemption is April 15, 2019. An application is available on the website, or feel free to contact the office.

Please be aware if you do not apply for this exemption, you will be assessed for the full value of your Solar Energy System for Tax Year 2019. You may not see the increase until the final tax bill in December, because the Town wide Revaluation will not be complete before the first tax billing.

If you are currently receiving a solar exemption on your property, you do not need to apply again.
