ATTENTION: OWNERS OF SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS



The Town of Farmington voted at Town Meeting in 2019 to raise the amount of the solar exemption to 100% of the assessed value of a qualifying solar energy system. This means that your taxes will not go up as a result of your solar energy system value, but **ONLY IF YOU HAVE APPLIED FOR THIS EXEMPTION**. The deadline to apply is April 15th. *****In 2020, the deadline is extended to June 1, 2020*****

Please be aware if you do not apply for this exemption, you will be assessed for the full value of your solar energy system.

If you are currently receiving a solar exemption on your property, you do not need to apply again.
