VETERAN'S CREDITS - the following credits are available:

1. **Veteran's Credit: \$500** (for qualifying veterans, their spouse or widow)
2. **Service Connected Total & Permanent Disability: \$2000** (for qualifying veterans, their spouse or widow)
3. **Surviving Spouse: \$2,000** (for spouse of any person who was killed or who died while on active duty in the armed forces of the U.S.)
4. **Total Exemption:** Total tax exemption for applicants who meet all requirements of State RSA 72:36-a **and** who own a specially adapted homestead acquired with VA assistance.

QUALIFICATIONS

- A NH resident for at least 1 year preceding April 1st of the year the credit is requested.
- Property must be the veteran's principal place of abode
- Property must be owned by the veteran or the veteran's spouse
- Must have served at least 90 days in a qualifying war or conflict
 - **WWII:** December 7, 1941-December 31, 1946
 - **Korean Conflict:** June 25, 1950-January 31, 1955
 - **Vietnam Conflict:** December 22, 1961-May 7, 1975
 - **Vietnam Conflict:** July 1, 1958-December 22, 1961, if veteran earned Vietnam Service Medal or Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal
 - **Persian Gulf War:** August 2, 1990 –
 - Any other war or armed conflict that has occurred since May 8, 1975, and in which the veteran earned an Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal or Theater of Operations Service Medal
- Must have been honorably discharged
- Must submit DD214 to Town along with Form PA-29
- If applying for Service Connected Total & Permanent Disability Credit, must have letter from Veteran's Administration
- Deadline to apply is April 15th
- **In light of the Coronavirus, deadline for 2020 is extended to June 1, 2020**
